I was looking for a light dinner on a hot night. I found this in my recipe collection. It's simple but add some warm garlic bread and you won't spend too much time in the kitchen.

Mediterranean Tuna Salad

Ingredients

- 3 hard cooked eggs, peeled and diced
- 1 (6ounce) can of tuna, water packed & drained
- 2 tablespoons finely chopped red onion
- 1/4 cup kalamata or black olives, sliced
- 1/4 cup crumbled feta cheese
- 2 teaspoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1/2 teaspoon red wine vinegar
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 4 cups mixed greens

Directions

1. Combine eggs, tuna, onion, olives, and feta cheese.

2. Combine olive oil and vinegar in a bowl and whisk until well blended. Serve over mixed greens.

JULY

As I reported last month, Doug Grass, our regional park manager, retired at the end of June. When I spoke with him in May about security improvements being made and those not yet underway he assured me that his successor has our proposal and that she will contact me to discuss them. I will follow up with her once she gets settled in. Below is the list of promised items that have recently occurred or will be implemented shortly.

1. Internet connection will be provided at both park entrances. New cameras will provide real-time feeds and memory storage to monitor all activity.
2. Each person renting space in the RV park will receive an individualized code so that every gate opening is traceable to their account. This will discourage space renters from sharing their code and make entry much more challenging for intruders.
3. A new, more substantial gate was installed accessing the RV park, and the new slats in the front fence are a cosmetic improvement.
4. Additionally, he said significant paving improvements will occur this summer, which we experienced in June.

In the May and June Criers I provided important, specific information about

dealing with trespassers and any troublemakers. The Citrus Heights Police Department wants to assure us that they have our back and want our residents to both feel and be protected. I will publish that information again another month, but I don't want to waste space and your time with over-redundancy. I am including one crucial paragraph from that information as it addresses a chronic problem that will only be corrected by consistent attentiveness and the right response.

ONGOING TRESPASSING

- If a known offender who has been issued a written or documented verbal trespass warning is still on your property and you want them cited and removed, **call the Citrus Heights Police Department at (916) 727-5500 and advise dispatch of the situation.** The police department will respond and issue a written citation for violating Penal Code 602(o) or 602(k) or arrest the individual.

COMMUNICATION: I invite all residents



to make me aware by email of your security experiences or concerns, and also to make suggestions for enhancing the appearance and functioning of our neighborhood.

Can you believe summer is here already? Yes, I can! It is hot this year, but hopefully a good growing season.

Here's a **BIG Shout Out of Thanks** to Luke and the Maintenance Crew for getting all the weeds out of the pathways and unclaimed garden plots in our FREE Community Garden.

MORE Good news. There are FREE spaces available for spring/summer planting. Go to the management office to assign one to YOU! Diane and Martha have at least two garden plots that are **READY** to plant. Some have stuff started already but you are welcome to take those plots for the season. It is not too late to plant so give us a call and get your gardening gloves on!!

CAUTION, be sure you are paying attention to your body when you are out gardening at home or in our free Community Garden. Wear your gardening hat and protect your skin from sunburn. Stay hydrated and go inside when your body says you have had enough. Those weeds will be there tomorrow!! Ha!

Remember that we can always use your large boxes broken down and devoid of tape and staples as well as your shredded paper and dry leaves in garbage bags. These items are helpful to keep the weeds down in unassigned plots and to put our gardens to bed for the winter. 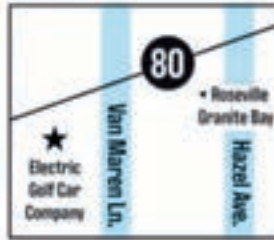
